Colonel David L. Musgrave Commander Pine Bluff Arsenal

COL David L. Musgrave assumed command of the Pine Bluff Arsenal, Pine Bluff, Arkansas on 17 July 2012. He is a Distinguished Military Graduate from Middle Tennessee State University with a Bachelor of Science Degree. He also holds a Master of Arts Degree in National Security and Strategic Studies and a Master of Science Degree in National Resource Strategy. His military education includes the U.S. Army Chemical Basic and Advanced Courses, Airborne School, the College of Naval Command and Staff, and the Industrial College of the Armed Forces (ICAF), National Defense University.

COL Musgrave's previous command positions include E Company, 1st Battalion, 46th Infantry Regiment, 1st Armored Training Brigade, Fort Knox, KY and the Blue Grass Chemical Activity, Chemical Material Agency, Richmond, KY. Joint service assignments include: Mission Commander, Chemical and Biological Division, On-site Inspection Directorate, followed by Executive Officer to the Deputy Director, Defense Threat Reduction Agency, concluding as the Senior Military Assistant to the Director, Defense Threat Reduction Agency (DTRA)/U.S. Strategic Command Center for Combating Weapons of Mass Destruction. In his most recent Joint/Combat assignment he served as the Aide-de-Camp to the Commanding General for U.S. Forces Iraq, OPERATION NEW DAWN.
