- Hunting may be closed or curtailed without advance notification due to military missions activities.
- Sportsmen are liable for their actions while participating in hunting and fishing activities and must comply fully with all PBA, State and Federal Laws and Regulations.

### Section 3 - Authorization

In accordance with Homeland Security Presidential Directive (HSPD) 12, Army Regulation (AR) 190-13 and Directive-Type Memorandum 09-012, all non-DoD Cardholders requesting/requiring access to DOD Installations must have a valid purpose to enter, have their identity verified and vetted to determine fitness, and be issued an Installation Access Badge (IAB). IAB's will only be issued to individuals who have successfully passed a National Crime Information Center Interstate Index inquiry (NCIC-III) check to determine each applicant's eligibility. The following criteria will prevent access to PBA: Senior Commander Determines a Potential Threat to the Installation; Fraudulent Identity Information; Arrest Warrant; Barred from a Federal Installation; Sex Offenses/Registered Sex Offender; Armed/Aggravated Robbery; Drug Possession with Intent/Purpose to Sell/Deliver; Drug Distribution; U.S. Espionage; U.S. Sabotage; U.S. Treason; U.S. Terrorism; U.S. Murder; Felony within 10 years; Felony Firearms or Explosives Violation; Acts or Activities Designed to Overthrow the U.S. Government by force, Identified in Terrorist Screening Database. In addition, the following criteria will prevent hunting on PBA: Felony or Domestic Violence; Possession, Use or Sale of Marijuana, Dangerous or Narcotic Drugs; Declared Mentally Incompetent; DUI/DWI within 5 years; Order of Protection.

## PBA PRIVATELY OWNED FIREARMS REGISTRATION

### PRIVACY ACT STATEMENT:

**AUTHORITY:** 10 U.S.C. 3013, Department of the Army; Army Regulation 190-14, Carrying of Firearms and Use of Force for Law Enforcement Security Duties.

**PRINCIPAL PURPOSE(S):** All privately owned weapons introduced, carried, used or stored on Pine Bluff Arsenal (PBA) must be registered with Pass and Registration Office via PBA Form 190-47, PBA Privately Owned Weapons Registration Form. Additional purposes may include: 10 U.S.C. 3013, Department of the Army; Army Regulation 190-14, Carrying of Firearms and Use of Force for Law Enforcement Security Duties.

**ROUTINE USES:** In addition to those disclosures generally permitted under 5 U.S.C. 552a (b) of the Privacy Act, these records or information contained therein may specifically be disclosed outside the DoD as a routine use pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 552a (b) (3) as follows: information is furnished to criminal justice elements outside the Department of Defense for investigation and prosecution when such cases fall within their jurisdiction or concurrent jurisdiction is applicable. These include: Federal Bureau of Investigation; U.S. Customs Services; Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms; U.S. District Courts; U.S. Magistrates; state and local law enforcement, wildlife conservation and public health agencies; and, in overseas areas, host government law enforcement agencies.

# Vetting Criteria Summary

- **Any person convicted of a **FELONY**.**
- **Any person convicted in any court of **DOMESTIC VIOLENCE**.**
- **Any person convicted of **DUI / DWI** within the last five (5) years.**
- **Any person with an **ACTIVE ORDER OF PROTECTION**.**
- **Any person who is presently declared as **MENTALLY INCOMPETENT** or who is **PRESENTLY COMMITTED TO ANY MENTAL INSTITUTION**.**
- **Any person who has been convicted in any court of the **POSSESSION, USE OR SALE** of marijuana, dangerous or narcotic drugs.**




# Arkansas Game and Fish Commission








# Explosive Arc Boundaries





## Area 5D – No POV's

**Areas 7W, 7C, & 7S are walk-in areas only for PBA employees with "D" access badges. POV's must be parked out-of-way of emergency vehicles.**



# Be Safe

**Hunter orange, chartreuse or blaze camouflage must be worn by all hunters during modern gun or muzzleloader deer season to comply with Arkansas Game and Fish Law. Water fowl hunters must wear the prescribed amount of hunter orange only when walking to or from a waterfowl hunting site.**



# Hang-on Stands, Climbing Stand, or Climbing Aids


**1) The safe use and operation of elevated hunting stands is the sole responsibility of the user. Only commercial stands that are manufactured, certified, or tested to industry standards may be used. Elevated stand equipment must be used in accordance with the manufacture's instructions. Owner's identification must be clearly marked on elevated stand equipment. Homemade elevated stand equipment shall not be used.**

**2) Always use a fall-arrest system (FAS) that is manufactured to industry standards and includes a full body harness. Attach the FAS to the tree while at ground level, and keep it attached throughout the hunt-from the time you leave the ground until you get back down.**



# Deer Stands

- 1) Stands must be removed by February 28. (Stand left after February 28 will become property of PBA Natural Resource Office.)**
- 2) Prohibited for use:**
  - 1) Screw in steps or gear driven into trees.**
  - 2) Permanent structures. (stand that cannot be safely moved by one (1) sportsman)**
- 3) All stands must have owners name, address, and phone number permanently attached. If not they will be removed.**



**Alcohol and Drugs are NOT permitted.**

**Rifles and Pistols are prohibited on PBA.**

**Weapons Transport:**

- 1) Unloaded & Cased**
- 2) Inaccessible to the driver & passengers within vehicle**
- 3) Ammunition shall not be in the same container as firearm**

**Baiting and/or planting food plots on PBA is not allowed.**

**Organized deer drives are not authorized.**

**Vehicles Regulations:**

- 1) Off-Road motorized vehicles are prohibited on PBA.**
- 2) Vehicles must remain on primary (paved) and secondary roads (gravel) ONLY!**



## **PBA Whitetail Seasonal Bag Limits**

- 1) A doe must be harvested and checked before a legal buck may be harvested during any hunt. Exceptions is two day youth hunt.**
- 2) No more than one buck may be harvested and a button buck must be tagged as a buck.**

## **Waterfowl Hunting**



**Yellow Lake, the Buckshot Pit and, the River Slough adjacent to the Arkansas River may be utilized for waterfowl hunting.**

**Hunting hours in these areas shall end at 12:00 pm. Waterfowl hunting after 12:00 pm is prohibited.**

**Yellow Lake, the Buckshot Pit and, the River Slough is closed to Fishing until noon during Duck Season.**

Hunting in a No Hunting Area	
Possession of an Unauthorized weapon to include a concealed weapon [5-6,c]	
Transporting a loaded weapon in a motorized vehicle [5-6,d,(3),(a-c)]

Guide Hunting for compensation [5-1,h]

Hunting without the prescribed amount of fluorescent orange [4-2,a]	3 years
Failure to complete Arkansas License regarding deer harvest after a kill and before moving the carcass	3 years
Removal of deer head prior to processing [5-1,c]	3 years
Shooting before or after legal hours [5-4,a-b]	3 years

### The following VIOLATION result in penalties listed.

Failure to display and/or present Vehicle Access Permit [7-4,a,(3)]	30 days
Failure to check-out of an area before leaving post through software system at the Game Check Station [Chapter 11]	30 days
Littering and/or dumping [3-1,e]	1 year
Knowingly hunting over or taking of game from a baited area [5-1,a]	1 year
Bypassing a roadblock, cable, or gate with a vehicle [3-4,c]	1 year
Possession of firearms while hunting in bow only area	3 years
Discharging a weapon across or within 200 feet of a maintained road or building or within 200 yards in the direction thereof [5-6,d,(5),(e)]	3 years
Taking of fish by unauthorized means [6-2, a-b]	3 years
Improper/inadequate safety equipment on boats [9-1,c]	2 years
Illegal use of game cameras	2 years


\* If a sportsman is caught assisting another sportsman in a violation the same penalties applies to both sportsmen.

## **Procedures for Game Check in at the PBA Game Check Station.**

- 1. Properly tag & field dress all deer in the field.**
- 2. Transport properly tagged deer to Game Check Station.**
- 3. Data Collection:**
  - 1. Weigh and extract jawbone.**
  - 2. Be sure that tag on jawbone matches game check sheet before placing jawbone in basket located beside skinning rack.**
- 4. Complete Processing your Deer.**

**\* Only deer harvested on PBA may be registered at PBA Game Check Station.**
